
Please use this guide to select appropriate decorative fixtures for your project. If in doubt, take this document to your local lighting showroom and ask for suggestions.

Notes:

- Match color temperature to fixture schedule and adjacent fixtures.
- Coordinate driver type with controls integrator for 1% dimming.
- Coordinate mounting type and requirements with electrician.
- Finish color selections by client.

Description:

The decorative exterior wall sconce should be pleasing to look at when on at full brightness, therefore bare visible bulbs are discouraged. Frosted, milky, or mica-like shades are generally best for diffusing light and providing a soft glow at the fixture itself.

The fixture should emit most of its light towards the ground, illuminating a wide area of the ground, patio, deck, or floor.

A moderate amount of light may be emitted upwards to catch on architectural details, soffits, overhangs, and ceilings above.

Size:

Height should be about 1/4 the height of the door, typically about 20" high for a 7' door.
